St. Fergus was an Irish bishop surname the Pict, who worked in Perthshire, Scotland and founded many churches. He is reputed to have died at Glamis, where his cult flourished into the fifteenth century. A well and a cave at Glamis still bear his name. He may be the bishop Fergustus, Bishop of the Scots, who attended a synod in Rome in 721.
