

St. Mabyn, nun of Cornwall

MABYN, (*Sixth Century*), according to Cornish tradition, St. Mabyn was one of the many children of King St. Brychan of Brycheiniog. The village and civil parish of St. Mabyn is named for her, and St. Mabyn Parish Church located in St. Mabyn, Cornwall, England, is said to have been founded by her. The earliest mention of her is in a twelfth century Life of St. Nectan. She is generally associated with St. Teilo.
